- 4. Monetary and/or ribbon awards will be given for top three places.
- 5. Picture size LIMIT: 24 x 36 inches or square inch equivalent.
- 6. All artwork must be done in current school year by student entering the work. Art made and/or entered in a previous year will not be accepted.
- 7. All exhibits should be labeled with name, address and phone number. We are not responsible for lost or broken items.
- 8. WORK MUST BE PROPERLY BASED FOR HANGING OR IT MAY NOT BE ACCEPTED.
